#### **QUALITY INSPECTOR**

#### **Key responsibilities**

- Plans and executes quality inspections and audits in accordance with the audit plan.
- Documents audit results and reports non-compliances to the Quality Manger.
- Reports to the Quality Manager, any obstacles or problems encountered during the execution of an audit.
- Monitors compliance with, and adequacy of, the procedures required to ensure safe operational practices and airworthy aircraft of the organization.
- Verifies that standards required by the Authority and any additional requirements defined by the organization are carried out by monitoring activities in the field of maintenance or flight operations.
- Maintains an up-to-date knowledge of aircraft maintenance or flight operations, airworthiness legislation and best industry practice as it affects the safe operation of the company's aircraft.

#### **Requirements:**

- Five (5) C.X.C/G.C.E passes including Mathematics and English.
- National Technician's Diploma in Mechanical Engineering Technology or acceptable equivalent of these qualifications.
- A course related to Quality Auditing Techniques would be an asset.
- Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Licence or acceptable equivalent.
- At least three (3) years' experience in Aviation maintenance or flight operations related activities.
- One (1) year experience in returning an aircraft to service would be an asset.
- Demonstrable knowledge of AW139 aircraft and its related manuals and systems.
- Sound knowledge of the TTCARs.
